CLEAN WATER SERVICES ADVISORY COMMISSION

The purpose of the Clean Water Advisory Commission (CWAC) is to review and discuss major policy issues and programs and make recommendations to the Board of Directors. The Clean Water Services Board of Directors is comprised of the individuals elected to the Washington County Commission. There are 15 Board-appointed members of CWAC and membership reflects a diversity of occupations and interests as follows:

- 5 from neighborhoods
- 2 owners or managers of businesses other than land development or construction
- 2 from the development community
- 2 from environmental organizations
- 2 from agricultural interests
- 1 non-voting member from Clean Water Services
- 1 non-voting member representing a member city

CWAC terms are for three years and meetings are generally held the third Wednesday of the month at the Clean Water Services Administration Building Complex, 2550 SW Hillsboro Hwy.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

The Clean Water Services public involvement process is designed to achieve the following results:

- Trust and credibility among all parties
- Agreement, consensus and support
- A sound policy foundation which provides clear direction as to how the policies are to be implemented
- Policies which are consistent with public values
- Timely decision making and appropriate action
- Identification of win-win solutions which improve the overall quality of decision making

WHO WE ARE. Clean Water Services is a water resource management utility for more than 520,000 people in urban Washington County and small portions of Multnomah County, Clackamas County, Lake Oswego, and Portland. Clean Water Services operates four wastewater treatment facilities, constructs and maintains flood management and water quality projects, and manages flow in the Tualatin River to improve water quality and protect fish habitat. Although Clean Water Services maintains a close working relationship with Washington County government, it is a separately managed and financed public utility.
