Program Guidelines

- Participants may be eligible for free native plants to be used in project area
- Program intended for sustainable stormwater development, not yard landscape design, lot-to-lot drainage or flooding problems
- Eligibility limited to residential property owners and neighborhood groups in the Clean Water Services service district
- Employees of Clean Water Services, its member cities and Washington County are not eligible to apply

- Provide natural filtration source
- Educate residents and community about healthy Tualatin River Watershed Practices
